Course Selection for Probationer Research Students

As part of your training and preparation for research, if you are intending to transfer to D.Phil status, you are expected to take four courses (M.Sc., advanced undergraduate, or reading) in your first year—as described in the *Graduate Research Student Handbook*. If you are planning to transfer to MSc by Research status, you are expected to take two courses, as above. Your choice of courses and the method of assessment (if different from the default for that course) are to be decided in discussion with your supervisor. **If you take a course not organised by the department you will need to arrange for the mark for your course to be given to Julie Sheppard, although this will be followed up if the mark is not received.** Please indicate on the form in the final column which method of assessment will be used. Any proposal for partial or complete exemption from the coursework requirement must be justified and supported by your supervisor—and is subject to approval by the Director of Graduate Studies. Having already completed an MSc is not generally justification for exemption.
